## Our Location

Hilltop Montessori School is located in the Town of Mt Laurel, on Abbott Square, past the playground.

**From Birmingham**, Take Highway 280 East to Hugh Daniel Drive. Turn left and proceed to Highway 41 (Dunnavant Valley Road). Turn right on 41 and proceed 1.3 miles. Turn left into Mt Laurel.

**Alternatively, from Birmingham**, Take Highway 280 East 3.5 miles past Highway 119. Turn left on Highway 41 (Dunnavant Valley Road). Mt Laurel is 3.2 miles on the right.

**From Chelsea**, Take Highway 280 West to Highway 41. Turn right, and travel 3.2 miles. Turn right into Mt Laurel.
